

COOKIE CLARIFICATION TEXT ON PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

Pursuant to the Personal Data Protection Act No. 6698 ("**Act**") , your personal data related to the cookies used on <https://www.fups.com> ("**Website**") may be processed by Lydians Elektronik Para ve Ödeme Hizmetleri A.Ş. ("**Company**") as the data controller to the extent described below.

Cookies are used on the Website to enable you and the relevant persons to benefit from the Website as efficiently as possible and to improve the user experience. If you do not prefer using cookies, you can delete or block them from your browser settings. However, we would like to remind you that your use of the Website may be affected.

What is a Cookie and Why is it Used?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your device or network server through browsers by the websites you visit. For more information on cookies, you may visit www.aboutcookies.org and www.allaboutcookies.org.

For What Purposes and Legal Reasons is Your Personal Data Processed?

The personal data collected from you will be processed for the purposes set out below ("**Purposes**"), within the terms and purposes of the processing of personal data set out in Article 5 of the Act. Cookies are used on the website for different purposes. Depending on the type of cookie used, the data processing purposes and the data processing obligation may change under the law on which we rely for the use of the particular cookie. **Mandatory Cookies** Mandatory cookies are cookies that are necessary for the proper functioning of the online services that are placed and offered on your device while you are visiting the Website. For the data processing activities that we carry out during the use of these cookies, we rely on the data processing condition "Personal data of the contracting parties must be processed if they are directly related to the establishment or performance of a contract" under Article 5 of the Act.

Performance and Analytics Cookies

Performance cookies allow us to track and analyze Website traffic with the number of people visiting the Website. Thanks to these cookies, we can obtain information about which areas of the Website are visited most often or least often, and we can optimize traffic on the Website. For the data processing activities that we carry out during the use of these cookies, we rely on the data processing condition "Data processing is mandatory for the legitimate interests of the data controller, provided that it does not adversely affect the fundamental rights and freedoms of the relevant person" under Article 5 of the Act.

Functionality Cookies

Functionality cookies are cookies that are necessary to provide certain functions on the Website and to remember your preferences for them. Functionality cookies are used to remember your language preference on the Website or to save your settings for the use of cookies. For the data processing activities that we carry out during the use of these cookies,

we rely on the data processing condition "Data processing is mandatory for the legitimate interests of the data controller, provided that it does not adversely affect the fundamental rights and freedoms of the relevant person" under Article 5 of the Act.

This type of cookies are used to remember your preferences and is stored by browsers on your device. When you visit the Website again with the same device, thanks to the persistent cookies, it will be checked if there is a cookie created by the Website on your device. To Whom the Processed Personal Data can be Transferred and for What Purpose?

Your collected personal data, collected in the context of fulfilling the above Purposes; may be transferred to our suppliers, our business partners, legally authorized public entities and legally

authorized private organizations, following the rules for the transfer of personal data set forth in Article 8 of the Act, under the data processing conditions regulated in Article 5 of the Act.

If you give your explicit consent, your cookie data may be transferred to Google Inc, Facebook, Yandex based abroad for the use of analytical cookies, following the rules for the transfer of personal data under Article 9 of the Act, under the data processing conditions regulated in Article 5 of the Act.

What is the Method of Collecting Personal Data?

Your personal data is collected electronically through cookies in the context of fulfilling the above Purposes.

What are the Rights of the Relevant Person Listed in Article 11 of the Act?

We hereby declare that you have the following rights as the relevant person under Article 11 of the Act:

- Requesting information regarding your personal data if they are processed,
- Learning the purpose of your data processing and whether this data is used for intended purposes,
- Knowing the third parties to whom your personal data are transferred in country or abroad,
- Requesting correction of personal data if it is incomplete or improperly processed, and requesting that third parties be notified of the processing carried out in this context,
- Requesting the erasure or destruction of personal data when the reasons for their processing no longer exist, although they have been processed in accordance with the Act and other relevant legislation, and requesting the communication of the transaction carried out in this framework to the third parties to whom your personal data have been transferred,
- Objecting to a result against you by analyzing the processed data exclusively through automated systems,
- Requesting the compensation if you suffer damage due to unlawful processing of your personal data.

If you submit your requests regarding your above-mentioned rights to our Company via the request form on www.fups.com or in any other methods stipulated by law, our Company will conclude the request as soon as possible, but no later than within thirty days,

depending on the nature of the request, free of charge. However, if the transaction requires additional costs, the fee will be charged by our Company according to the tariff determined by the Personal Data Protection.
